Club Time Trials

Summary:

 We ran 14 clubs TT's at Betteshanger, with a total of 668 rides (excluding 25 & 4up TTT)

 We ran 7 club TT's on Thanet Way, with a total of 145 rides – 3 events cancelled due to poor weather conditions

Summary:

 In 2015 83 riders from the club completed in 356 times in club TT's... More riders – less rides (28%)

 In 2014 60 riders from the club completed in 493 times in club TT's— (help & ride 1st year)

 In 2013 63 riders from the club completed in 511 times in club TT's
